Style	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Little to no reporting language used</li> <li>Informal language; inappropriate to the task</li> <li>Reporter is unnecessarily subjective</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Some reporting language used</li> <li>Tone is mostly appropriate. May be informal at times.</li> <li>Reporter is mostly neutral</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Reporting language used</li> <li>Appropriate and professional tone</li> <li>Reporter neutrality achieved; reads as a genuine news article</li> </ul>
Conventions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Little to no evidence of proofreading</li> <li>Major spelling and/or grammatical errors that impede meaning</li> <li>Awkward sentences or word choice</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Some errors in spelling and grammar, but meaning generally is clear</li> <li>Some awkward sentences or word choice</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Proofread, polished, and free of spelling and grammatical errors</li> <li>Writing flows and appears effortless</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Missing many minor parts, or missing any major parts: nameplate, news articles, photos, advertisements</li> <li>Articles are not all related to the topic and major details are inconsistent</li> <li>Newspaper is poorly formatted; major editing needed; does not resemble a newspaper</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>May be missing up to two minor parts: date, cutlines, credit lines, page numbers</li> <li>Articles are mostly related to the topic but some minor details may be inconsistent</li> <li>Articles are typed; formatting is mostly appropriate and consistent; some editing is needed</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fulfills all requirements with nothing missing</li> <li>All articles are related to the topic and details are consistent</li> <li>Articles are neatly typed in columns</li> <li>Formatting is neat and consistent; newspaper looks professional</li> </ul>
